OUC is Upgrading the Transmission System in Your Area

Work will begin soon at Cyrils Drive

To ensure long-term reliability and meet growth demands in Central Florida, OUC – The *Reliable One* is building a new 21-mile, 230 kV transmission line. The project extends from OUC's existing St. Cloud East substation in unincorporated Osceola County to OUC's Magnolia Ranch North substation in unincorporated Orange County and will serve both counties. Construction is anticipated to be completed by Spring 2025.

Work at Cyrils Drive

Although most of the transmission line is being built overhead, an underground portion will be constructed to cross underneath Cyrils Drive between the neighborhoods of Del Webb Sunbridge and Weslyn Park. This portion of work is anticipated to begin by the first week in June 2024 and be completed by August 2024. Please plan for traffic delays, lane shifts, and partial lane closures. Street parking in front of Weslyn Park will be unavailable. Sidewalk traffic near the work areas will be diverted for public safety.

The underground work includes excavation to install an underground duct bank, manholes, and the transmission line. Once this construction work is completed, the road will be returned to pre-construction condition. No power outages are anticipated during this project.
